

BOARD MEMBERS:
REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

Board members may be removed from Board membership for incompetency, official misconduct, intoxication (on or off duty), non-attendance of regularly scheduled board meetings, or conviction by a jury for any felony or for misdemeanor official misconduct. "Official misconduct" includes conviction of an offense relating to violation of purchase procedures. Actions for removal of Board members must be brought before the district judge holding jurisdiction, except that any court convicting a Regent of a felony or official misconduct shall order immediate removal. *Tex. Const., Art V, Sec. 24; Loc. Gov't. Code 87.011, 87.013, 87.031; Education Code 130.0845.*
