ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING PROGRAM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application Deadline February 15, 2019 for Summer Admission June 1st

Application Instructions: Please read **carefully** and follow **all** instructions:

1. If you are not currently a Galveston College student, you must apply for admission to Galveston College following the guidelines in the General Catalog. Along with the application to the College, submit Official Transcripts from all universities and colleges you have attended to the **Office of Admissions, 4015 Avenue Q, Galveston, Texas 77550.**
The Galveston College application is separate from the one required by the Associate Degree Nursing Program (ADN). Applicants will be considered for admission for the Nursing Department after students are admitted to Galveston College.
2. Submit the attached application for admission to the Department of Nursing in the Regents Hall of Galveston College by ***February 15, 2019***. This application is formatted for download from the Nursing Department webpage and completion on your computer (except for your signature). Once completed, print, sign, and submit the application. Hard copy applications are also available from the Nursing Department.

Transferring applicants will be evaluated on the following basis:

- A. **Grade point average of 2.5 or > for science courses:** BIOL 2401, 2402 and 2421. These courses must be within 5 years of program start.
- B. **Grade point average of 2.5 or > for all prerequisite courses:** HPRS 1206 Essentials of Medical Terminology; ENGL 1301; RNSG 1215 Health Assessment; and meet the Math requirement.
- C. **Most recent term GPA of 2.7 and overall GPA 2.7 or higher**
- D. **Prior to acceptance a standardized test in Fundamentals of Nursing must be taken on a date TBD depending on the semester on entry.**
- E. **The transfer student must take a dosage and calculation exam and pass with a score of 90% or higher and pass a skills check-off.**
- F. Admission criteria are listed on the Galveston College website in the nursing section and in the General Catalog.
