- 5. List your current GPA (grade point average) and attach a copy of your current high school or college transcript.
- 6. List your major or program of study.
- 7. Attach two letters of reference. Suggested source: employers, teachers, other school officials (high school or college), social worker, counselors, ministers, and civic leaders. Letters of reference must be on professional letterhead.
- 8. Type the required original essay containing 250 words or less about your needs and/or goals related to how a scholarship will help you advance your educational goals.
- 9. List any other related information, such as clubs you are or were a member of, community volunteer service, awards or honors.
- 10. It is highly recommended that you complete a FAFSA application at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- 11. Turn in all of the required materials by the due date. Late applications will not be considered.
